<b>Other ineligible items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prizes exceeding €50 or for achievements unrelated to GCE activity</li> <li>Wellbeing activities or events with no link to human rights</li> <li>Charity donations</li> <li>Food for parties</li> </ul>			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cost associated with Tidy towns or litter picking - contact County Council</li> <li>Trip/Visits with no/weak GCE scaffolding</li> <li>Garden material with no link to human rights or local to global</li> </ul>
